Settlement Fund: Approximately \$1,220,000,000

Period of Claim: 1990 through 2019

Filing Deadline: June 18, 2020

Summary: The lawsuit claims that the Defendants conspired to fix, maintain, and artificially raise the price of component parts and as a result, individuals and businesses paid more than they should have for the vehicles in which those parts are contained.

Eligibility: Your company can file a claim for money benefits if you bought or leased new vehicles and/or certain parts between January 1, 1990 and 2019 in The District of Columbia and the following states: Arizona, Arkansas, California, Florida, Hawaii, Iowa, Kansas, Maine, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Mexico, New York, North Carolina, North Dakota, Oregon, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Utah, Vermont, West Virginia and Wisconsin.

Documentation: The Claims Administrator requires proof of purchase/lease documents to support your claim.
