## Currently filing late claims

Settlement Fund: Currently \$576,750,000

**Period of Claim:** March 1, 1995 through November 25, 2007

Filing Deadline: December 7, 2015

**Summary:** The lawsuit claims that numerous Defendants conspired to fix, raise,

maintain or stabilize prices of CRT Products resulting in overcharges to consumers who bought CRT Products such as televisions and computer monitors. This applies to individuals and businesses that purchased any CRT Product from a retail store, supplier or some other seller for their own use and not for resale between March 1, 1995 through November 25, 2007. On September 19, 2013, the US District Court for the Northern District of California certified plaintiff classes in 21 states (AZ, CA, FL, HI, IA, KS, ME, MI, MN, MS, NE, NV, NM, NY, NC, ND, SD, TN, VT, WV, WI) and the

District of Columbia.

**Please note:** All we need is the total number of TV's or computer Monitors purchased and at this time there is no back up documentation required to file your claim.

\* Indirect means that you did not buy the CRT product directly from any of the defendants, but from a retail store, supplier or some other seller.
