On September 18, 2018, a Superseding and Amended Definitive Class Settlement agreement was filed with the court. This proposed \$5.56 - \$6.26 billion settlement will provide payments to merchants who accepted Visa and Master Card at any time from January 1, 2004.

Settlement Fund: Proposed \$5.56 - \$6.26 billion

Eligibility: If you are a merchant who accepted Visa and Mastercard at anytime from January 1, 2004, you may be entitled to a substantial payment resulting from a class action settlement

Period of Claim: Anytime from January 1, 2004

Claim Filing Deadline: TBA

Summary: The terms of this proposed settlement would modify, amend and supersede the previous agreement which was reversed by the Second Circuit Court of Appeals on June 30, 2016.

Claim forms and payments are not available at this time. If the court grants final approval and any appeals are resolved, the Court will approve a claim form and set a claim deadline.
