If you are a Washington organization who purchased televisions, monitors, Notebook Computers, Color-Screen Cell Phones, or Color-Screen Ipods containing LCD flat panels between January 1, 1998 and December 31, 2006, you may be entitled to a substantial payment resulting from a class action lawsuit

PERIOD OF CLAIM: January 1, 1998 to December 1, 2006

SUMMARY : This class action lawsuit, brought by the Washington State Attorney General on behalf of the State of Washington, is an antitrust lawsuit involving the price of thin-film-transistor liquid-crystal-display flat panels ("LCD Flat Panels"). The complaint alleged that the Defendants participated in an unlawful conspiracy to fix, raise, maintain, or stabilize prices of LCD Flat Panels, resulting in damages to consumers who bought finished products containing an LCD Flat Panel.

ELIGIBILITY: Washington consumers that purchased LCD televisions, flat screen monitors, notebook computers and color-screen iPods between January 1, 1998 and December 1, 2006 and Color-screen cell phones purchased between January 1, 2004 and December 1, 2006 are eligible to receive a payment from the settlement funds. This applies to LCD Products purchased from a retailer or someone other than the manufacturer of the component flat screen for their own use and not for resale.
