SUMMARY: A class action lawsuit has been brought on behalf of indirect purchasers of the following products that contained Lithium-Ion Cylindrical Batteries, which is a type of Lithium-Ion Battery ("Li-Ion Battery"): (i) portable computers; (ii) power tools; (iii) camcorders; (iv) mobile phones; or (v) replacement batteries for any of these products.

ELIGIBILITY: The Class includes all persons and entities who, as residents of the United States and during the period from January 1, 2000 through May 31, 2011, indirectly purchased lithium ion batteries for their own use and not for resale. "Indirectly" means the product was purchased from someone other than the manufacturer, such as a retail store.
