If you purchased any Pork product directly from a Pork producer for use or delivery in the United States from January 1, 2009, through January 12, 2021, you may be eligible for a substantial payment from some class action settlements.

In re Pork Antitrust Litigation, D. Minn. Case No. 0:18-cv-01776

Settlement Fund: \$83,000,000

Period of Claim: January 1, 2009 – January 12, 2021

Filing Deadline: Open

Summary: Direct Purchaser Plaintiffs allege that Defendants and their co-conspirators conspired and combined to fix, raise, maintain, and stabilize the price of Pork products, beginning at least as early as January 1, 2009, with the intent and expected result of increasing prices of Pork products in the United States, in violation of federal antitrust laws

Eligibility: All persons who purchased Pork directly from any of the Defendants or any co-conspirator, or their respective subsidiaries or affiliates for use or delivery in the United States from January 1, 2009 through January 12, 2021. If you satisfy these criteria, then you are a member of the Settlement Class. While this Settlement is only with Smithfield, the Settlement Class includes persons who purchased Pork products (as defined in the Settlement Agreement) from any of the Defendants or their co-conspirators.
