ELIGIBILITY: The Class includes all persons and entities who, as residents of the United States and during the period from January 1, 2000 through May 31, 2011, directly purchased lithium ion batteries from one or more of the defendants.

SUMMARY: The lawsuit alleges that Defendants and co-conspirators conspired to raise and fix the prices of Li-Ion Cells for over ten years, resulting in overcharges to direct purchasers of Li-Ion Cells, Li-Ion Batteries, and Li-Ion Products. "Lithium Ion Battery Products" or "Li-Ion Products" means products manufactured, marketed and/or sold by Defendants, that contain one or more Lithium Ion Battery Cells manufactured by Defendants or their alleged co-conspirators. Lithium Ion Battery Products include, but are not limited to, notebook computers, cellular(mobile)phones, digital cameras, camcorders and power tools and replacement batteries for these products.
